



# Puppy Wellness Program

At Arroyo Veterinary Hospital, we're committed to the wellness of your puppy and we want you to have all the information you need to make an informed choice concerning his care.

The first few months in a puppy's life is critical in terms of disease prevention and becoming a part of the household. Spending time with our staff and doctors now will pay off as your puppy becomes an adult. It's important to realize that this program is not just about shots!

**Program includes:**

- ◆ Physical exams at 6-8, 10, 13, 16 and 18 weeks
- ◆ DA<sub>2</sub>PPV vaccination for Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza and Parvo Virus
- ◆ Lepto vaccination for Leptospira type diseases
- ◆ De-worming - Virtually all puppies are born with worms or pick them up soon afterbirth. Some of these parasites can be transmitted to humans, especially children.
- ◆ Fecal exam - This test will allow us to determine if any internal parasites are present that are not being taken care of by the de-worming.
- ◆ Bordatella vaccine - Protects against Bordatella virus which causes kennel cough
- ◆ Behavioral consultation on training, socialization, and problem prevention
- ◆ Rabies vaccination
- ◆ 10% discount on **a spay or neuter**

We recommend that you also consider microchipping your puppy.

**Microchipping** - If he or she is ever lost without a collar and ID tag a microchip can identify them if they go to a shelter, humane society or veterinary office. AVH has a microchip scanner. You can have the microchip inserted at our hospital. This is a quick and relatively painless procedure. We often do this at the same time that we do the spay or neuter.

**Flea/Tick Control** - Every dog needs to be placed on heartworm prevention (Heartgard®) and routine flea and tick control (Advantage®, Advantix® or Frontline®) to prevent the irritation and disease caused by fleas and ticks.
